With the help of Jason from Straightline Performance and Olle from Oktan AB Sweden, Marcus Ogemar from Östersund, Sweden will join the team in the Pro-Lites Class for the first part of the season in the U.S. The accomplished young rider has won the Swedish National Championship, a Clash of Nations Gold, and is the current FIM World Snocross Champion for 2015 so racing ISOC ACS was the logical next step in his career.
