#### "THE LOVING PARTY"

Reynolds is a proud supporter of the Old Lyme Historical Society, which just finished working on a joint project among the Old Saybrook Historical Society, the East Lyme Historical Society, the Salem Historical Society, and the Lyme Public Hall Association called "The Loving Party! Signed on January 7, 2015 by representatives of the five cities proclaimed February 13, 2015 marks that 350<sup>th</sup> anniversary of an historical event in which the development of four settlements branched from Old Saybrook in order to maintain their own religious affiliations!

However the first branch from Saybrook to Lyme was the most important because it marked the **first time in state history** that a city was branched from a settlement which was proclaimed on February 13, 1665. An agreement was signed by representatives from both sides of the river known as *The Loving Party*, due to the amicable nature of allowing another city to be established in order to maintain and the continuation of their religion.
