



At SafeinHome, we understand that most seniors want to live at home for as long as possible. However, we also understand that they value their independence and may not be convinced that SafeinHome is something they want in their home. We hope these tips will help you assure your Mom or Dad that the SafeinHome system is an effective tool for helping them to remain independent and at home.

TIPS ON TALKING TO YOUR PARENTS

1 First, give your parent a brief overview of the SafeinHome system:

- It is a system of motion sensors that let us know that you're okay and moving about the house with your normal routine, and if not, it lets us know that too with customizable alerts;
- Door Sensors let us know if the front or back doors have been left open;
- Temperature Sensors let us know if the stove has been left on;
- The Personal Call Button can alert your family, friends, or emergency services if needed;
- It contains an optional electronic Pillbox that can help remind you to take your medications.
- The SafeinHome system has no cameras so you get the privacy you deserve.
- All of the information is sent to our mobile devices, so we can see that you're okay at any time, from anywhere.

3 Address any concerns they may have with the system:

- It is not a camera! SafeinHome can't be used to see inside your home, it only detects movement.
- The information it sends out can only be viewed by me and any other loved ones we agree should have access (such as family members or trusted neighbors).
- SafeinHome keeps your information private, and does not share it with anyone. In fact, SafeinHome maintains the same privacy standards that doctors and hospitals use to handle a patient's medical information!
- Setting up the system is simple and doesn't involve drilling holes in the walls or bulky equipment. It only contains a small electronic box (the size of a small answering machine) and discreetly placed sensors.

2 Secondly, explain the benefits of SafeinHome to your parent:

- SafeinHome provides peace of mind not only for us, but for you too. It lets us know you're okay, anytime and from anywhere, when we can't be there with you.
- We want to help you live at home for as long as possible, and SafeinHome can help you to stay independent while giving you the privacy you deserve. (no cameras!)
- We can customize the alerts to fit your daily routine, so that if something is out of the ordinary we will know about it sooner.
- If you have an accident, SafeinHome can help alert us sooner in case you're unable to call for help. It even offers a Personal Call Button that will immediately notify us and/or emergency services if needed. The emergency notification can be set up to only alert family.
- You don't need to do anything differently, or learn how to use any new equipment. Leave that up to us!

4 Most importantly, ask for permission to install the system:

- Would you be willing to let us put this system in your home to try it out? You don't have to do anything, we'll come over and set it up!



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
