Slow Cooker Chili By Angela Gamble, MS, RD, LD



Ingredients:

1½ lb. 96% lean ground beef

1 tsp oil

1 medium onion, minced

- 1 medium green and 1 medium yellow bell pepper, diced
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1-10oz can diced tomatoes
- 1-8oz small can plain tomato sauce
- 1-15oz can white kidney beans
- 1-15oz can black beans
- 1/4 c. low sodium chicken broth
- 1 tsp cumin
- ½ tsp chili powder
- ½ tsp paprika
- ½ tsp kosher salt

Instructions:

- 1. Heat beef in skillet over medium heat, season with salt and cook until brown. Place into the slow cooker
- 2. Add the oil to the skillet and sauté the onion, garlic and bell pepper over medium heat for about 4 to 5 minutes. Spoon over the meat in the slow cooker and stir in all other ingredients.
- 3. Cover and cook on HIGH 4 hours or LOW 6 hours. Serve with low-fat cheese, sliced avocado, and whole grain crackers.

Stillwater Medical Center Home Health Services (SMCHH) obtained licensure with the state of Oklahoma in October of 1992, with five patients under the guidance of the late Pat Riley, RN and the late Mary Jo Sohrwide, RN. SMCHH quickly grew from those five patients to a robust home health agency that now employs 35 staff members. A full complement of services is offered including nursing, aide, social services, dietitian services, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy. With more than 400 combined years of nursing and therapy experience, the staff at SMCHH stays abreast at how to best serve our patients.

SMCHH provides care across the fifty mile radius around Stillwater and serves over 31 communities and their surrounding rural areas. Over 1000 visits by trained clinicians are provided to the residents in this area every month. From infant care provided through the WISHH (Women's, Infant Skilled Home Health) program, to the

care of senior citizens to promote as much independence as is safely possible, SMCHH provides services across the spectrum. They provide post-acute care to patients with conditions such as CHF, COPD, and diabetes to assist with prevention of returning to the hospital. SMCHH employs skilled individuals and modern technology to ensure the highest possible level of quality. New technology such as vein view finders can be utilized in the home setting to assist nursing staff in venipuncture while decreasing the discomfort of the patient.

SMCHH has received awards for quality care and five stars for patient satisfaction most recently. SMCHH employs the March of Dimes Community Nurse of the Year (Jeanne Campbell, RN, IBCLC) and the Oklahoma Association of Home Care & Hospice Therapist of the Year (Pam Wimberley, PT). Our greatest accomplishment is the honor of caring for those who choose the services of our agency.

In 1992, Stillwater Medical Center began their endeavor to providing compassionate home care by purchasing medical equipment services from Calvin Anthony and Tiger Drug. After renaming to Cimarron Medical Supply, located at 9th and Walnut, and with five employees, we expanded our services to the surrounding community and also to nursing homes and doctor's offices throughout the state.

CMS moved our retail store to the Eastgate warehouse location in 1997. At this time, our name was changed to Cimarron Medical Services as we continued to expand our medical equipment services, and decided to concentrate on providing quality care to our patients at home.

In July 2017, CMS moved again to our new location on 12th street, next door to the SMC Plaza, six blocks from the hospital. This move has given us the ability to

better support the hospital, doctors, and community members of Stillwater by expanding our retail store and knowledgeable staff at a convenient location.

CMS employs 17 staff members ranging from respiratory therapists, certified mastectomy fitter, custom mobility specialist, customer service representatives, technicians, billing and account specialists, managers and retail staff.
