Elliott Burns Races To Top Five Finish At The Big House. Moves Into The Top Ten In Pro Mod UTV Points

Aurora, Minn. (June 27, 2017) - In just the his second race in the world of closed-course UTV racing, Scheuring speed sports driver Elliott Burns continued to climb the ladder with a fourth place finish at the legendary off-road course in Crandon, Wisconsin.

Burns wrapped up day one missing the final podium spot by just one car length. Elliott was one of only four drivers to turn sub 50 second laps throughout the race. On Sunday, Burns had to start his U.S. Air Force/AMSOIL/Can-Am X3 near the rear of the field after morning qualifying was rained out. He immediately began working his way to the front and the drop of the green flag. On lap two he caught a rut and cart-wheeled in the air and landed back on all fours with some damage to the rear suspension. He immediately got back on the gas with a slightly damaged machine and worked this way back to a top ten finish in seventh place. Elliott is now in the top ten in points, even after missing the first race of the series in Chicago.

"I am thrilled at the rate our program improves on a race-to-race basis," said team owner Steve Scheuring. It shows the knowledge, the hard work ethic, and great group of partners Scheuring speed sports has."

Next up are rounds eight and nine in Bark River, Michigan on July 15-16.
