## Tim Tremblay Sweeps The Grand Prix Ski-Doo Valcourt

**Aurora, Minn. (February 14, 2017)** Tim Tremblay dominated the 34th running of the Grand Prix Ski-Doo Valcourt, sweeping all three days of Pro Open snocross competition in front of 20,000 fans in the birthplace of Ski-Doo snowmobiles.

Tremblay was nearly undefeated during the weekend, winning all but one heat race in which he finished runner-up to teammate Lincoln Lemieux. Lemieux had a great weekend of his own, finishing second on Friday night and fourth on Saturday. Lincoln was in position to give the team another 1-2 finish on Sunday when he was taken out while trying to pass a lapped rider. Lemieux rebounded to complete the final in fourth place.

The team will be home in Minnesota this week before resuming the AMSOIL Championship Snocross tour on February 24, in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan, where Tremblay will continue to defend the red plate of the points leader in his quest to capture the team's first-ever Pro Open title.
