Lincoln Lemieux Opens The Season With Two Podiums On The New Ski-Doo Gen4 Racer

Aurora, Minn. (November 27, 2017) With new production-based rules in place, an all-new platform Ski-Doo racer and only a few weeks to prepare, Lincoln Lemieux showed that he and the AMSOIL, U.S. Air Force, Ford team will be a force to be reckoned with as he turned in solid, come-from-behind third place finishes at each day of the season-opening AMSOIL National in Duluth, Minnesota.

“First weekend racing on the new platform I’m very happy,” said team owner Steve Scheuring. We have some work ahead of use but we’re going to keep getting faster. We’re just starting out with the machine and we know we have room to grow, where some of the other manufacturers have spent years with their sleds and will have a little harder time making big gains.”

“It was a good weekend,” said Lemieux. We finished 3-3 but I felt like we had a chance at second both days. Tucker was kind of out there in his own world but we have a brand new sled and we are still working through all the bugs. We were definitely faster every time we went on the track. Hopefully we can just keep the momentum up heading into Wyoming and get on the top of the podium.”

Tim Tremblay was still feeling the effects a practice crash coming into the weekend but gutted it out on Saturday to capture a top five finish in the main event. Tremblay was also battling Bronchitis during the weekend, which started to get the better of him on Sunday. He was still able to qualify for the main event where he finished 11th and is looking forward to an open weekend to fully recover before rounds three and four.

Leading up to the holiday race the team made multiple school visits in conjunction with the U.S. Air Force. At the conclusion of each visit we awarded a \$200 Race To The Future Scholarship to a student who is pursuing a career in a technology-related field.

Up next is a new venue at Snow King Mountain in Jackson Hole, Wyoming on December 8-9.
