Tim Tremblay Doubles Up On Podiums At Route 66

Aurora, Minn. (March 6, 2016) Tim Tremblay turned in a pair of third place finishes over the weekend to solidify his place near the top of the AMSOIL Championship Snocross Pro Open standings.

Tremblay had a great weekend throughout qualifying never finishing worse than second place in his heat races and winning two of the four.

In a continuing sign of force by the squad, much of Tremblay's competition in Joliet came from teammate Lincoln Lemieux. Lemieux, who also qualified well with a first and two seconds, finished just behind Tremblay on Friday in fourth place. On Saturday, Lemieux had the sixth pick on the gate and endured a heated battle at mid pack before securing the fifth spot at the end of the race.

Max Taillefer started strong in the Pro Lite division winning a heat race each day but had some trouble in the finals each night finishing 15th and 13th.

Prior to the event, the team made appearances at technical schools in the Chicagoland area presenting Race To the Future scholarships in conjunction with the U.S. Air Force. We also had several USAF personnel spend time in our transporter at the event.

The team will return home this week to prepare for the three round season finale at Lake Geneva, Wisconsin, where important point battles are on the line.
