

Tim Tremblay Survives Grand Finale To Secure Second Place In Championship!

Aurora, Minn. (March 17, 2015) The towering slopes of the Grand Geneva Resort played host to the final weekend of the AMSOIL Championship Snocross tour with several positions in the Pro Open standings hanging in the balance.

After running off a month-long streak of podium finishes which put him in the title chase, Tim Tremblay was plagued with rare mechanical issues for much of the weekend, limiting his success in the main events. Fortunately, solid qualifying races with one win and multiple top three finishes generated enough points to lock down second place in the championship.

Pro Lite rider Max Taillefer had his most consistent weekend of the year finishing sixth on Saturday and fifth on Sunday from a back row starting spot. As a result, Max climbed two positions in the year-end standings to finish eighth overall.

Finale weekend also marked the team's last school visit of the season as we made a pre-race stop at Badger High School in Lake Geneva, where we awarded one final Race To The Future Scholarship on behalf of the U.S. Air Force.
