

Championship Battle Heats Up As Tim Tremblay Finishes Second and Fourth In Minnesota

Aurora, Minn. (January 12, 2015) Tim Tremblay continues to be a man on a mission, racing to a second place in Friday night's AMSOIL Pro Open main event after an early race battle for the lead. Tremblay followed up his performance with a fourth on Saturday, holding tight to the number three position in the championship, where he sits just four points out of second.

Canterbury Park is one of the premiere race venues on the national tour with generous amounts of stadium lighting and indoor seating where Ski-Doo fans were able to watch the the number 11 machine launch to great starts all weekend in both qualifying and final round action.

Unfortunately, the team's second rider, Lincoln Lemieux, suffered a season-ending injury when he hit a hole in the track at a bad angle while making a pass on a competitor. Lemieux, who joined the team late last year as a fill-in rider, has been a standout in his rookie season, showing vast improvement over the summer and running at the front of a very competitive field of pro racers.

The team has the upcoming weekend off but will be traveling to Colorado to begin testing for the ESPN Winter X Games in Aspen, where Tremblay will be seeking his first gold medal. The following week will begin a series of back-to-back rounds on the national tour, criss-crossing from the Deadwood Shootout in the Black Hills to upstate New York for the Seneca Allegany U.S. Air Force National.
