Tremblay Back On Podium, Mees Regains Form

Aurora, Minn. (February 4, 2013) Tim Tremblay continued his charge to the top of the Pro Open standings with a third place finish at the opening night of the Deadwood Shootout in Deadwood, South Dakota. Following on his heels was team rider Robbie Malinoski, who still leads Tremblay in the season standings by two points in third overall.

Malinoski has been plagued by nagging injuries the past couple of weeks but has managed to turn in consistent enough finishes to stay in the championship fight. On Saturday, Malinoski and Tremblay had to race from deep in the field but worked through the pack to finish eighth and ninth respectively.

Darrin Mees had been struggling in recent weeks to get comfortable on a freshly built sled but turned things around on Saturday when he was the second overall qualifier and just missed the podium with a fourth in the main event.

The team has been on the road racing and testing for several straight weeks and is looking forward to returning to the Midwest with renewed confidence and a race package that is suite to the traditional style tracks and elevation that will round out the season.

Up next are ACS rounds 9-10 from Traverse City, Michigan on February 8-9.
