Robbie Malinoski Repeats As Friday Thunder Champ

Aurora, MN (January 24, 2012) Robbie Malinoski turned in a dominating performance at the Friday Night Thunder portion of the AMSOIL Eagle River World Championship Snowmobile Derby, winning both of his qualifying heat races and sailing, unchallenged, to the top of the podium in the main event.

Home of the first ever organized snowmobile race, Eagle River is steep in tradition and an event that every true racer wants to have on their resume. The track celebrated its 49th consecutive year of hosting the World Championships with a capacity crowd on Friday night and again for Sunday's finals.

Malinoski and teammate Darrin Mees both qualified on the front row for Sunday's World Championship final and both riders earned heat race victories in the process. Malinoski was a favorite to win the Championship race but was hit in the first turn, rolling his sled and forcing him to remount at the end of the field. Mees finished fourth overall, narrowly missing the podium.

Prior to our arrival in Eagle River, the team took part in a number of school visits in Wausau and Rhinelander, Wisconsin where we awarded two more Race To The Future Scholarships in conjunction with the U.S. Air Force.

The team rig is now on site in Aspen, Colorado for the Winter X Games, supporting freestyle athlete Justin Hoyer who will be taking part in Snowmobile Freestyle and Snowmobile Best Trick.
