I'm looking forward to a little break with the holidays but we're going to put our heads down and go to work."

Darrin Mees has continued to impress everyone on the tour in his rookie season in Pro Open. With main event finishes of 5th and 7th on the weekend, Mees has a firm hold on the number five position in the Pro Open standings.
