Tremblay Tops Qualifying, Continues Trend

Aurora, MN (January 7, 2013) Tim Tremblay, the reigning Pro Open champion, has continued his pattern of ramping up his speed and results as the season grinds on. Tremblay finished no lower than second place during both rounds of qualifying in Shakopee, Minnesota, but continues to encounter bad luck at the start of main events.

Tremblay cart-wheeled off the start of Friday's main event before re-joining the action one-lap down to the leaders. Tremblay kept pace with the front runners as they lapped through the field, making it to eighth place at the checkered flag.

On Saturday, Tremblay was making a pass for second place early in the final. When contact was made with another rider the officials decided it was an aggressive move and black flagged him for the incident.

Robbie Malinoski also had solid qualifying runs on Friday and was in third place in the main event when a plastic tab on a wiring connector broke, eventually causing the terminal to dislodge and cut power to the motor. Malinoski came back to finish eighth on Saturday and still sits near the top of the standings in second place.

Up next is the Eagle River World Championship Derby in Eagle River Wisconsin on January 19-20.
