Tremblay Sweeps Grand Prix de Valcourt

AURORA, Minn. - Tim Tremblay's return home to his native Quebec did not go unrewarded as the reigning AMSOIL Championship Snocross Pro Open Champion swept all three days of competition at the Grand Prix de Valcourt.

Although not an ACS tour event, the Grand Prix is one of the most historic races of the season as it is held in the hometown of Ski-Doo snowmobiles in a province whose people are passionate about all things, especially snowmobiles.

"This is the only race I am doing in Quebec and all my family and friends and all the riders I grew up with racing motocross and snowmobiles were there, so it was really cool," said Tremblay. "

It was also a great weekend for the team, as Robbie Malinoski and Darrin Mees each had a second place finish and were never out of the top five during the three days. The riders and mechanics were also able to work side by side with the Ski-Doo race shop at the factory as they continue to make improvements for the home stretch of the ASC tour.

"All weekend we were able to try new things and make the sled better for the nationals, that was the point," said Tremblay. "For sure we made ground but we are going to keep testing this week to make things better."

Up next are rounds 11-12 of the AMSOIL Championship Snocross tour, February 22-23 in Salamanca, NY
