

Do you have a patient that needs financial assistance to cover the costs of surgical procedures?

Who benefits?

The Noronha Benevolent Care Fund provides financial assistance to cover the costs of surgical procedures and/or related hospital stays for patients served by providers or facilities affiliated with Davis Health System.

What are the guidelines?

- Patient is a candidate (or has received) medically necessary, non-elective general surgery, including but not limited to Joint Replacement, Cataract, Exploratory Arthroscopy, and/or Podiatry Services
- Patient is unable to meet self-pay responsibilities or satisfy required co-pay or deductible amounts
- The patient is uninsured or under-insured (patient's total deductible or out-of-pocket responsibility is \$8,000 or more)
- Third party coverage (governmental or commercial) has been applied or denied
- Patient meets eligibility requirements per the current Davis Health System Financial Assistance Policy, including a total household income at or below 300 percent of the U.S. Federal Poverty Guidelines
- Davis Health System Foundation reserves the right to extend Financial Assistance in exceptional circumstances outside of these guidelines
