JET-A-MARINA SERIES RULES

1. Your boat motor must conform to BIA, NMM, U.S. coast Guard, or manufacturer horsepower ratings.
2. All boats must be equipped with Coast guard approved kill switch.
3. Winners will be determined by Tournament Officials based on boat weight.
4. Choose your own partner or fish alone.
5. No more than two contestants per boat. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. Fishing with artificial baits only is authorized. There will be NO trolling. All fish must be caught in a conventional sporting manner.
7. Only largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass, caught between legal tournament hours, will be weighed.
8. All fish must be 15" or more to be weighed. NO EXCEPTIONS! Violation of any state law is grounds for disqualification. Penalty 1 lb. and loss of that fish.
9. Five fish limit per boat. Culling must be done when 6th fish is caught. At no time can a boat have 6 fish in the boat or the live well.
10. BFL measuring board will be the Official Board used.
11. Contestants must check in with officials between 5:00 am and 6:30 am on the day of the tournament to receive your boat tag. You cannot have your live well checked without a tag.
12. Area inside tournament sight marina break wall is OFF LIMITS.
13. There will be an 8 oz. penalty for each dead fish.
14. Live wells will be checked by the tournament committee prior to the start of the tournament.
15. Late penalty will be 1 lb per minute. 15 minutes late, lose all credit for the day's catch.
16. No alcoholic beverages allowed!
17. Contestants must fish Lake Barkley or Kentucky Lake. Lock through is prohibited.
18. Coast Guard approved PFD must be worn when combustion engine is running above idle speed.
19. There will be no double qualifying for the Championship tournament.
20. Decisions of Tournament Directors are final.

JET-A-MARINA SERIES RULES

All forward facing and 360 degree sonar transducers shall be prohibited on tournament dates of April 18, 2026 and October 25, 2026. Forward facing transducer are defined as any transducer that provides live images. 360 degree transducers are defined as any transducer producing a beam that rotates 360 degrees.

Each contestant agrees to submit, by signature on the "Liability Release and Entry Form", to a polygraph examination. Failure to pass a polygraph examination will result in disqualification. Also, refusal to take the examination will result in disqualification.

Decisions of the tournament directors are final.
