Feature	Benefit	Additional Information
Side air discharge spacers	Extremely even temperature throughout trailer	By allowing some air to escape towards the front of the chute improved air temperature distribution can be attained
Ramped mesh chute end	Minimize the possibility of tearing down the chute during loading while maintaining excellent air distribution	By not having a loop of chute material at the end for cargo to catch on during loading the possibility of tearing down the chute is greatly reduced
Heavy-duty vinyl material	Long-lasting durability	Vinyl material has industry leading tear and tensile strength
Heavy-duty polyethylene material	Long-lasting durability	Polyethylene material has great tear and tensile strength while being a very economical option
Hardware Included	Correct hardware is included for installing the chute with or without the side air discharge spacers	Rivets and spacers are both included with all chutes except the full Velcro chutes. The rivets included have a longer grip range to work with or without the spacers
Velcro on Chute End	Provides additional protection against chute tear down	Chute can be installed with or without using the Velcro at the end of the chute. The Velcro at the end of the chute is 10' in length.
Velcro Chute Adapter	Prevents damage to chute during loading and allows for quickly moving chute out of the way for dry loads	The Velcro chute adapter also greatly speeds up installation and allows for the unit to be pulled off the front of the trailer for service when the trailer is loaded.
Precedent Specific Chute Adapter	Fast, perfectly aligned installation	The Precedent adapter bracket attaches directly to hardware in the rear of the unit and greatly simplifies the installation process
