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## Home Health Care Services

## Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Services (CDPAS)

CDPAS is a statewide Medicaid Program that provides an alternative way of receiving home care services where the participant (consumer) has more control over who provides their care and how it is provided. The goal of the program is to give individuals in need of assistance more control over personal assistance services.

The consumer is in charge of hiring their own assistant they can choose anyone they feel comfortable with including friends, family or neighbors. The flexibility of CDPAS and how it is administered is what makes it unique. It promotes independence and gives the consumer a true sense of involvement in the decisions making process with his/her own care.

### Who is eligible for CDPAS?

- Must be a New York State resident
- Must be eligible for Medicaid
- Must be authorized for home care services
- Must be willing and able to take an active role in hiring, supervision and termination of personal assistants
- Must be self-directing or have a representative that can direct your care
