Required Documentation for Insurance Coverage

The following documentation must be provided for ALL types of manual wheelchair configurations.

(Copy of medical record documenting F2F examination by treating physician showing the beneficiary was evaluated/treated for a condition supporting the need for the equipment). |
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Standard Wheelchair

The medical record **MUST** document:

- The wheelchair is required and will improve the beneficiary's ability to participate in MRADL's inside the home.
- Details about the significant impairment of the beneficiary's mobility limitations.
- The beneficiary has sufficient upper body strength and mental capabilities to self-propel the chair or has a caregiver willing and able to assist.
- The mobility limitation cannot be sufficiently resolved by the use of a cane or walker.
- The beneficiary is willing to use the manual wheelchair provided in the home.
- Height and weight of patient.



Heavy Duty Wheelchair

The medical record **MUST** document:

- All documentation required for a standard wheelchair
- The patient exceeds 250lbs

Extra Heavy-Duty Wheelchair

The medical record **MUST** document:

- All documentation required for a standard wheelchair
- The patient exceeds 300lbs
