<u>Additional Competition Team Audition Information</u>

Last year our **Competition Teams** were divided into three levels: Recreational Comp, Intermediate Comp, and Elite Comp. Our tuition was broken down and discounted by hours of dance per week.

Elite Competition – Dancers were required to attend 4-6 Hrs of dance each week that included a ballet tech class, Jazz/Tap technique, a production class, and 2-4 individual choreography classes based on style of dance. They competed in three Competitions, one local and two out of town, along with being offered the option of participating in Nationals in the cities. An example of tuition charged for Elite level is as follows: Headliners 2014-2015 – 1.5 Hrs of Jazz/Tap Technique per week, 45 Minutes of Contemporary Dance (Optional), 45 Minutes of Musical Theater (Optional), 45 Minutes of Production (Optional), 45 Minutes of Tap (Optional), 1.5 Hours of Ballet 3 per week.

Intermediate Competition and Rec Competition – Dancers were required to attend 2-3hrs a week depending on age and level. Technique class and choreography class as usual and some students were suggested to take a Ballet tech class, as well. They competed in two Competitions, one local and one out of town, with the option of participating in an additional Competition if decided as a team. An example of tuition charged for Inter/Rec level is as follows: Jr. Romeo & Juliettes 2014-2015 – 1 Hr of Choreography per week, 1 Hr of Technique per week

All dancers interested in Competition Teams should choose on their audition form what level of team they are most interested in competing on. Other factors will be determined in making the choices in who makes which level but it's good for the instructors to see what level each dancer is willing to be committed to. Please keep in mind that even if you select a certain level of Team, it is not guaranteed that it is necessarily the level you might make.

Here is more information about our **Hip Hop Competition Teams** for every child interested in auditioning for those. Last year we had three Competitive Hip Hop Teams:

Dude Factor - An all-boys group, competes in an Intermediate/Elite Competition level, meets once a week, went to 3 Competitions this year, and is choreographed by Jenn Madill Hagen

NOTE: All other unisex Hip Hop Competition Teams will be put together and choreographed by Sophia Amborn. They will compete at a Recreation level and will be able to choose how many Competitions they are interested in attending next year.
