U.S.G.A. RULES GOVERN PLAY

EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- ❖ Out-of-Bounds - defined by white stakes - 1, 2, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 15th hole.
- ❖ Direct water hazard defined by yellow lines - 6, 7, 11, 12, 14, 15 and 17th hole.
- ❖ Lateral water hazards defined by red lines - 2, 6, 7, 13, 14, 15 and 16th hole.
- ❖ All uncut areas inside the golf course to be played as lateral hazards. (Player also cannot ground club or remove loose impediments).
- ❖ Embedded ball rule in effect through the green.
- ❖ Drop area may be used on 12 or 17th holes.
- ❖ Gas Carts - please keep on cart paths and in rough as much as possible. Do not drive close to greens and traps.
- ❖ Repair all ball marks on greens. Rake traps.
- ❖ Please put rakes back in traps.
- ❖ Play starts on No.1 tee, except by permission of Pro Shop.
- ❖ All players must register at Golf Shop.
- ❖ Proper golf attire at all times.
- ❖ Red, White & Blue stakes at the 150 yard marker & on the Par 3's denote Front, Middle or Back placement of pin.
